The City Council and Mayor of Lumpkin met for a workshop on Monday, August 26, 2019 at 6:00 at the above address with the following members present: Mayor Jimmy Babb, Mayor Pro-tem Barbara Cullefer, Councilwoman Billie Ann Mallory, Councilwoman Flossie Brown. Absent were Nikita Seay and Mitzi House. The City Manager, David Davis, was present. City Clerk Anne Holloway was present to take minutes.

Mayor Jimmy Babb called the workshop to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance, which was followed by the roll call.

Mayor Babb asked for review of the minutes to be approved at our next regular meeting.

**Public Appearances –**

Mrs. Betty Kramer- stated that she rescued animals for Angel Dog Rescue and that she had several dogs and cats at this time. Mayor Pro tem Barbara Cullefer stated that they were a nuisance for the Baptist Church and they continue to have problems with the cats and dogs during church time. Mrs. Kramer stated that it was Georgia and Alabama law that the cats were free range animals. Chief Jackson stated that he would get with her about the animals. She agreed to keep them locked up during church time or special occasions.

Annette Miranda – DPS Recovery spoke on how their service could benefit the City – Taxes, Bills and Speeding Tickets. Chief Jackson stated that they had used a company like this in a former city. It helps collecting the tickets that are two years or older.

Mr. Moore – spoke about opening a half way home on 636 Liberty St. The Best Rescue Ministry, he said, would minister the whole person and bring money into the City. Ms. Brown – asked if he had tried to do this before in Lumpkin? Mr. Moore stated that they had been in Lumpkin before.

**Reports from Department Heads** – City Clerk Anne Holloway – Reminded the Council that Mrs. Jones and myself will be at training September 8-10, 2019. Would like to check into QS1 to see if we can add the water finances to our program and what it would cost.

Mr. Davis- the City is moving along nicely. We did change the speed limit signs on Holder Road.
