2020-21 City Budget – The Council needs to review the budget. Mayor asked if anyone had questions about the budget. We provide rubber boots but not boots wear every day. Billie Mallory- The cost of General funds – the lost. A. Holloway – Due to the Covic 19 will cause a loss to the City. The City Council for the training – \$2000 divided by six. That is not enough for travel and meals. Administration for the Salary – City Manager is that a raise of \$1140.00- City Clerk – No increase, but who is Police Clerk? That is City Clerk the Clerk is divided by Police Dept., Administration, Street, Sewage and Water. Overtime – There is an increase of \$800.00. The Clerk was on Salary first of the year then went to hourly. Attorney fee – That is the amount

that we paid out in this budget. River Valley - that is a membership fee paid annually. Professional cost – It all the contractors that have to contractor, engineers, and others. Utility and Elections – There is not an election upcoming year. Utility has been divided into each department. Hot spots – The Police Department uses them for the computer system to write tickets. TYSY – that is for the annual fee for the Visa fee. QuickBooks – charges for payroll and taxes. Billie Mallory – It is much more informative than last year. A. Holloway – We were just getting started. Public Works – Is there an increase in Supervisor and Assistant Supervisor? Anne Holloway – That is the amount that he was paid last time. Billie Mallory – that needs to be refigured. Supplies – there was an increase of \$17,000.00. Billie Mallory – What are Quick books? It was not in the budget last year? Anne Holloway - Quick books is the payroll and QS1 is the utility billing. Solid Waste – Is the waste for the City.
